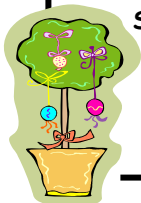


Ivy Kids Garden

Theme for the Month: My Pet

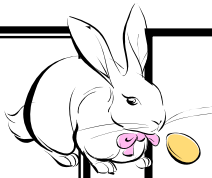
Purpose: To provide activities that promote language, listening and visual stimulation.
